- A. Informal Bidding Procedures Pursuant to the California Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Act (CUPCCAA) Darren Sylvia

- B. California Disaster Assistance Act/Emergency Tree Removal Fred Faysal & Patrick Jensen

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We are moving forward with Vining Forest Products for tree removal. We are applying for a grant to offset the cost of removal. Tree removal will be complete prior to school starting on Aug 17th. Claudia Box asked, "When it says smaller trees does it mean oaks or just small trees?" It means the smaller trees that are dead.

C. Fencing by Valley Fence Co. for JV Softball Facility at Minarets – Darren Sylvia The installation of the fence will allow us meet the compliance for Title 9 equitable facilities. We did the informal process for bids for the fencing job. Valley Fence Co. had already installed other fencing on our athletic fields at Minarets, therefore, they fencinging will match. Claudia Box asked if the fencing installation would be timed with the blasting? Darren said that the blasting has already been done. Decisions will need to be made on how to proceed with what material (grass or synthetic) will be used on the infield and outfield. Fred Faysal and his team will continue to work on the berm and retaining wall.
